## **STUDENT HEALTH INFORMATION SHEET**

Every student needs to fill out a Student Health Information Sheet. If you need a form, please contact the school office and one can be sent home with your child. Please fill these out as soon as possible and return them to school so we can be made aware of any health situations.

If your child needs to take prescription or non-prescription medication, a form also needs to be filled out and kept in the school office along with the medication in its original container. These forms can be picked up from the school office.

## **STUDENT PICK-UP AT THE END OF THEIR SCHOOL DAY**

At the end of the school day, children need to be picked up within 15 minutes after being excused at 3:00 p.m. If parents have not picked up their children within 15 minutes at 3:15 p.m. after being excused, the students will then be sent to AFTER SCHOOL CARE at the Grant Street Building where parents will pick up their child.

Parents and children should use the cross walks when crossing the street. The Grant Street teachers in 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade walk their children outside at the end of the day. Parents of children in 3-year-old, 4-year-old and Kindergarten will need to come into the building to pick up their child.
