They are still looking for volunteers so if you could help please contact your child's teacher.

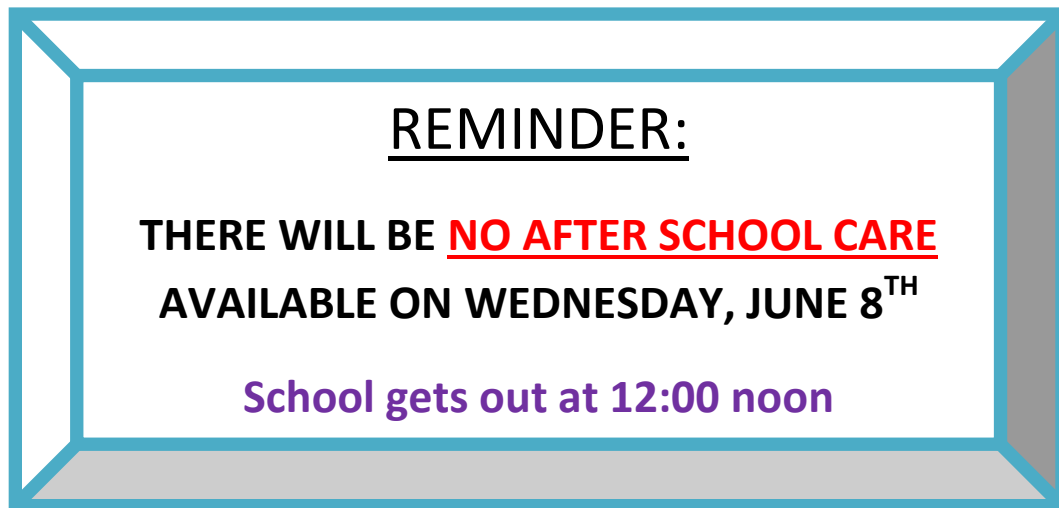
