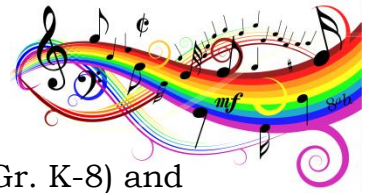
Join the Divine Connections team in providing Thanksgiving meals for those in need.

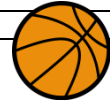
