We're supporting a new mission this month, the Milwaukee Medial Mission to Buccaramanga, Columbia! For 29 years, this mission has been sending Christian doctors and nurses from Froedtert Hospital to operate on nearly 100 children each year in Columbia. These surgeries include cleft lips and palates, hand and finger deformities, burns, and many ear deformities. The children are very impoverished, so in addition from receiving free medical care, they are also given care packages. These packages contain hygiene products and small toys. At St. Paul's we'd like to help support this mission through our offerings and also by collecting any small toys to be included in the care packages for the young patients in Columbia. These items can be anything little and should be new or gently used. For example, beanie babies, hot wheels, crayons, coloring pages, bracelets, hair ribbons, etc. The children are thrilled with whatever they are given! 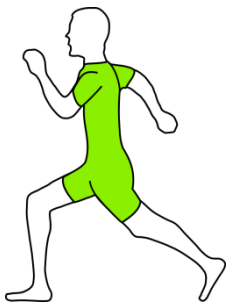
