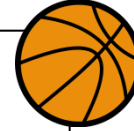
WINTER SPORTS

know if you can join us! Let's praise the Lord with our instruments and celebrate our team!

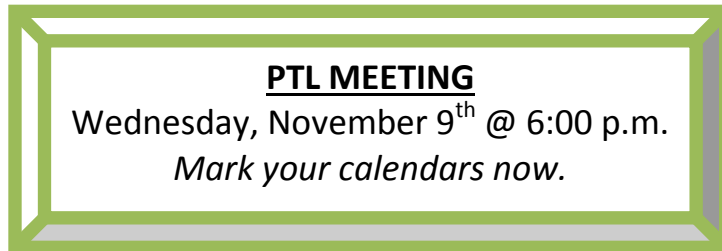
UPDATE BOX TOPS CONTEST

Last week's totals are as follows: 3K - 0; 4K - 9; K - 169; 1st Grade - 112; 2nd Grade - 25; 3rd/4th Grade - 360; 5th Grade - 134; 6th Grade - 72; 7th/8th Grade - 229. 3rd/4th Grade is in the lead with 7th/8th Grade a strong second. For anyone not familiar, "Box Tops for Education" is a program that schools can participate in to raise funds for their school. It's easy to participate! Box Tops are on many different products.
